

Adoption of the Shopfront Design Supplementary Planning Document

Statement of Adoption

In accordance with Regulations 11 and 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is hereby given that Canterbury City Council adopted the Shopfront Design Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on the 7th December 2020. This SPD was prepared to support the implementation of Policies HE9 (Advertisements affecting heritage assets) and HE10 (Shopfronts) of the Canterbury District Local Plan (adopted 2017).
